



# Quick Copy

## You will need:

- 3 - 5"x2.75" landscape photos & 1 - 3.75"x 2.25" landscape photo
- 1 x cardstock (for background)
- 1 x patterned paper
- Patterned paper scraps
- 1 x small die cut paper/journaling block
- Various letters for title
- Small number stickers for date
- Buttons

## Steps:

1. Cut centre out of patterned paper leaving a 1 inch "frame" for your page border.
2. Trim background cardstock to 11.5 inches x 11.5 inches and adhere to centre of patterned paper frame.
3. Give your smaller photo a mat using the patterned paper that we cut from the centre in step 1.
4. Adhere your larger photos to your page. Use the sample layout as a placement guide. They are about 6cm in from the right side of your layout and start just a touch in from the top and bottom of your cardstock.
5. Before adding the smaller photo to your layout, adhere your small die cut paper about 1.5cm in from the right side of your layout, overlapping the two larger photos slightly. Go ahead and adhere your last photo to the page.

6. Now it's time to add the three strips on the left hand side of the page. You can use patterned paper scraps (approx 1.5cm wide) or lengths of ribbon. Try varying the textures and patterns for a fun look.
7. The first strip is 6cm in from the left side of your layout. It starts from the bottom and is 19cm long. Leave a small gap between strips. The middle strip is 28cm long and is centred on the page and the right hand strip is 26cm long and starts from the top.
8. Go ahead and add your title along the left side of your layout. Mix and match the lettering styles on your layout.
9. Use your small number stickers to add a date or year to the right side of the bottom photo.
10. The last step is to add your buttons, using the sample layout as a guide for placement. Of course you can use any accents on your layout such as flowers, flourishes, chipboard or cut out shapes etc.
